Boiler Continuing Education for 3-Year Licenses

Background:

On July 1, 2008, boiler licenses are moving to a three-year licensing cycle. As part of that process, the Board of Boiler Rules approved new continuing education rules to accompany the new licensing cycle. The new rules take effect July 1, 2008.

Discussion:

The new continuing education rules require:

- Class 2 licensees to take 8 hours of continuing education every three years
- Class 3 licensees to take 24 hours of continuing education every three years
- Class 4 licensees to take 24 hours of continuing education every three years
- Class 5 licensees to take 24 hours of continuing education every three years
- Class 5A licensees to take 24 hours of continuing education every three years
- Class 5B licensees to take 24 hours of continuing education every three years

Continuing education credits no longer need to be earned on a yearly basis, they can be earned any time within the three-year license cycle.
