**Re: HB 3462 (2009), Phase II- Pilot Training Program Rulemaking Advisory Committee**

The Building Codes Division is forming a rulemaking advisory committee regarding the implementation of House Bill 3462, approved by the 2009 Legislature. HB 3462 authorizes the creation of a pilot program to train and certify individuals as specialized inspectors authorized to enforce portions of the specialty codes. The bill also authorized the division to establish a process for renewing certifications.

The division is implementing HB 3462 in two phases. Phase I, which dealt with inspector and building official certification renewal periods, processes, and fees, was finalized at the end of 2009. The rules for Phase I implementation can be found at:

This committee will deal exclusively with implementing Phase II of HB 3462. The overall committee size will be 7 to 9 members. At this time, the committee is expected to have approximately 2 to 4 meetings beginning in February 2010.
